#### Recommendation of Working Group to Monitor Tribal Sub-Plan

2957. SHRIMATI SUMATI ORAON : Will the Minister of HOME AFFAIRS be pleased to state :

(a) whether the Working Group on Monitoring set up by the Planning Commission to report on the physical results achieved as a result of financial investments in the Tribal sub-plan during 1974-79, was able to piece together a fuller and more coherent picture of achievements, State-wise/Union Territory-wise;

(b) if not, the various limitations as spelled out and recommendations based thereon as suggested by the working Group.

(c) whether the Planning Commission, in the aftermath of recommendations of Working Group, feels that sound monitoring systems and well defined data communication lines for collecting and relaying data/informations both in physical and financial terms, in the Tribal sub-Plan areas have been laid down by the concerned States/Union Territories during the current plan period; and

(d) if not, the remedial measures suggested therefor and implementation thereof within a specified time-frame ?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS (SHRI NIHAR RANJAN LASKAR) :

(a) and (b) The Ministry of Home Affairs, on the suggestion of the Planning Commission, Constituted a Working Group on Evaluation of Tribal Development and Development of Backward Classes Sector in July, 1978 with terms of reference (i) to study the existing monitoring system in respect of tribal development and development of Backward Classes Sector, and (ii) to make suggestion for improvement in the system in the context of the five year plan. The Working Group suggested establishment of a monitoring system in the Ministry of Home Affairs, the Planning Commission, State Governments and the Union Territory Administrations. No separate monitoring machinery existed during the Fifth Plan period. The Working Group for the Sixth Plan recommended establishment of monitoring machinery at the Centre and in the States. Consequently, monitoring machinery has been established at the Centre and in the different States.

(c) and (d) The State and Union Territories were requested by the Ministry of Home Affairs in December, 1979 to give effect to the recommendations contained in the Report. The monitoring system in the States is being reviewed during plan discussions. The evolution of a perfect monitoring system is a continuing process.
