3966. Shri S. M. Banerjee: Will the Minister of Defence be pleased to state:

(a) whether the Unit Production Committee has been functioning for the last 4 years in 505 Army Base Workshop, Delhi Cantt.;

(b) if so, how many meetings of this Committee were held during the last four years; and

(c) how many suggestions were put forward by the workers' representatives and out of these how many were implemented by the Workshop authorities?

The Minister of Defence (Shri Krishna Menon): (a) The Production Committee in 505 Army Base Workshop, Delhi Cantt., has been functioning smoothly since February, 1955 except during the period January 1957 to July, 1958.

(c) 98 suggestions were put forward of which 93 have been since implemented. On the remaining suggestions action is being taken.
