Discontentment among People affected by Koel-Karo Hydel Project

7829. SHRI PIYESH TIRKI : Will the Minister of ENERGY be pleased to state :

(a) whether it is a fact that the people affected by Koel-Karo Hydel project in Ranchi District of Bihar have been opposing it;

(b) if so, details of the land to be acquired for the project with the number of villages and families to be uprooted;

(c) details of Government's proposal for the rehabilitation of the displaced people; and

(d) details of the demands of the people of the affected areas?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF ENERGY SHRI ARIF MOHAMMAD KHAN: (a) The local people including tribals, affected by Koel Karo Project have been resisting acquisition of land for the project and access to the project site to project personnel.

(b) About 49420 acres of land will be required for the project which is spread over 106 villages and belongs to 11691 land owners. Out of this 3191 acres of land is forest land.

(c) and (d) A compensation and resettlement scheme for the affected people has been finalised as per statement in consultation with the State Government and the representatives of the local people.
