### Closed Unit of Remington Rand in West Bengal

242. SHRI P.R. DASMUNSI : Will the Minister of LABOUR be pleased to state :

- (a) whether any meeting on closed unit of

Remington Rand of West Bengal was held in Delhi in August, 1996;

- (b) if so, the salient features thereof; and

- (c) the progress in this direction so far?

THE MINISTER OF LABOUR (SHRI M. ARUNACHALAM) : (a) to (c) A meeting was held in the Ministry of Labour on 22-8-96 at New Delhi with a view to exploring the possibility of reopening the closed unit of Remington Rand India Ltd.

During the meeting it was decided that the Management will send their proposal to the concerned trade unions who will in turn send their response to the appropriate authority which is the State Government of West Bengal. Accordingly, the response of the trade unions to the management's proposal has been communicated to the Government of West Bengal for appropriate action.

### Illegal Calls

- (a) whether the Government are aware about a news regarding making some foreign calls by some of the employees of Kinwat Telephone Exchange in Nanded district of Maharashtra;
