(c) and (d) Tourism schemes are not drawn up State-wise They are formulated on the basis of factors such as tourist preferences, accessibility of the tourist Centres travel patterns, etc. The total outlay on tourism schemes during the Louith Plin Period is Rs. 25 crores in the Central sector including six crores for hotel and transport loans to the private sector.
