THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF STEEL AND MINES (SHRI SHAHNAWAZ KHAN): (a) to (c). A statement is laid on the Table of the House. [Placed in Library. See No. LT—1204/71]

(d) Steps to meet the demand would include attempts to step up domestic production by both short-term and long-term measures. Substantial measures will continue to be taken to increase imports, streamline distribution and regulate exports to meet the demand.

Censoring of Indian Publication in United Arab Republic

2607. SHRI P.K. DEO: Will the Minister of EXTERNAL AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the attention of Government of India has been drawn to a report in the Statesman of 25th July, 1971 stating that the United Arab Republic has censored publication of the Indian Embassy advertisement in a local daily in Cairo concerning India's point of view on Bangla Desh; and
- (b) if so, the reaction of Government of India in this regard?
