(a) whether the attention of Government of India has been drawn to a report in the *Indian Express* of the 15th November, 1971 containing the statement of the Pakistani Commander in East Bengal Lt. Gen. Amir Abdullah Khan Niazi saying that his country was training three special units of Razakars and is arming and equipping some of them for operation in India from East Bengal ; and

(b) the action, if any, being taken to prevent such subversive activities ?

THE DEPUTY MINISTER IN THE MINISTRY OF EXTERNAL AFFAIRS (SHRI SURENDRA PAL SINGH) : (a) Yes, Sir.

Memorandum from Kerala Minerals Employees' Association

(a) whether Government have received any

representation or memorandum from the Kerala Minerals Employees' Association, Quilon with regard to their grievances ; and

(b) if so, the decisions taken by Government thereon ?

THE MINISTER OF LABOUR AND REHABILITATION (SHRI R. K. KHADILKAR) : (a) A representation dated 16-10-71 from the Kerala Minerals Employees' Association was received by the Assistant Labour Commissioner (Central), Ernakulam on 23-10-71.

(b) Most of the demands raised in the representation are covered by a settlement dated 22-7-1968 which is still current. In respect of the remaining demands Assistant Labour Commissioner (Central) Ernakulam is making efforts to hold a joint meeting with the representatives of the Management and workers with a view to bring about a settlement.

Deposits of Iron Ore in Madhya Pradesh

(a) whether some sizeable deposits of iron ore have been located recently in Madhya Pradesh ; and

(b) if so, the main features thereof ?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF STEEL AND MINES (SHRI SHAHNAWAZ KHAN) : (a) and (b). No sizeable deposits of iron ore have been located recently by the Geological Survey of India in Madhya Pradesh. However, as a result of detailed investigations carried out by the Geological Survey of India in Madhya Pradesh in the past, total reserves of iron ore of about 2055 million tonnes in Bastar district, 360 million tonnes in Drug district and 122 million tonnes in Jabalpur district have so far been estimated.
