Loss incurred by Bharat Ophthalmic Glass Project Limited

3322. SHRI KRISHNA CHANDRA HALDER: Will the Minister of INDUSTRIAL DEVELOPMENT AND SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY be pleased to state:

(a) whether the loss in Bharat Ophthalmic Glass Project Limited is on the increase;

(b) the main reasons for the losses and;

(c) how Government propose to stop the recurring loss?

THE DEPUTY MINISTER IN THE MINISTRY OF INDUSTRIAL DEVELOPMENT (SHRI PRANAB MUKHERJEE): (a) No, Sir. The estimate loss for the current financial year is Rs. 85.00 lakhs against Rs. 92.87 lakhs for the year 1971-72.

(b) The losses suffered by the Company are mainly due to extremely low utilisation of the installed capacity. This is attributable to (a) certain technological problems and (b) low labour productivity due to unsatisfactory industrial relations.

(c) The following steps have been taken to improve the economic viability of the plant:—

1. The technological problems have been sorted out to a great extent;
2. With the Tripartite Wage Settlement entered into with Trade Unions in October 1971, which provided for substantial wage increases and also with the introduction of incentive scheme with effect from 11th Sep-
