THE DEPUTY MINISTER IN THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS (SHRI F. H. MOHSIN): (a) Government have seen some press reports, particularly, about non-implementation of the 20-point Economic Programme by the State Governments of Gujarat and Tamil Nadu.

(b) and (c). Yes, Sir. The implementation of the 20-point Economic Programme in all the States is under constant watch and review by Government.

## Religious or Communal Riots in the Country after declaration of Emergency

Acavailable informacording to tion, there have been no communal riots of serious nature in the country after the promulgation of emergency. In fact, the overall communal situation in the country has shown noticeable improvement after the promulgation of emergency. However, 58 minor 🧈 incidents with communal overtones are reported to have occurred in various parts of the country during the period July to November, 1975. Most of these incidents had occured due to miscellaneous causes arising from private quarrels between individuals, while a few had occurred on grounds of religious dispute land/property disputes.

#### C.I.A. Activities in India

176. SHRI S. M. BANERJEE: Will the Minister of HOME AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether C.I.A. activities in the country have increased;
- (b) if so, what steps have been taken to ban C.I.A. aided institutions; and
- (c) what other steps have been taken to combat this growing menace?

THE DEPUTY MINISTER IN THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS F. H. MOHSIN): (a) to (c). Government is aware of scope of activities of foreign intelligence agencies including the C.I.A. in this country and is maintaining the fullest vigilence in this matter. It will not be in public interest to close details of measures taken in this regard.
