The Deputy Minister in the Ministry of Food, Agriculture. Community Development and Cooperation (Shrj Shyam Dhar Misbra): (a) Yes, Sir.

(b) Rs. 28.17 lakhs.

- (c) (i) 23 pilot projects are functioning in Maharashtra.
  - (ii) An amount of Rs. 85.91 lakhs has been sanctioned as central share of assistance.

## Co-operative Movement in Maharashtra

2588. Shri D. D. Mantri: Will the Minister of Food, Agriculture, Community Development and Cooperation be pleased to state:

(a) whether any loan or aid was given by the Cen re to the Maharashtra Government during 1965-66 to gear up the co-oper stive movement in that State; and

(b) if so, the detai's thereof?

The Deputy Minister in the Ministry of Food, Agriculture, Community Development and Cooperation (Shri Shyam Dhar Misra): (a) and (b). Yes, Sir. A loan of Rs. 74.07 lakhs and a grant of Rs. 21.85 lakhs have so far been sanctioned through the National Co-operative Development Corporation. Further assistance due on the basis of plan outlay will be sanctioned before the close of the financial year on receipt of details of anticipated expenditure from the State Government.

## Agricultural Farm in Maharashtra

2589. Shri D. D. Mantri: Will the Minister of Food, Agriculture, Community Development and Cooperation be pleased to state:

(a) the acres of land brought under the Centrally-controlled agricultural farm in Maharashtra;

(b) the number of labourers working on it;

(c) the quantum of crop expected from it by the next agricultural season; and

(d) the basis of payment to the workers?

The Deputy Minister in the Ministry of Food, Agriculture, Community Development and Cooperation (Shri Shyam Dhar Misra): (a) There is no Centrally-controlled agricultural farm in Maharashtra.

(a) whether Government have sought increased technical assistance from Japan for stepping up the yield per acre of rice in India; and
