Thefts in Chitra Gupta Road and Aram Bagh, New Delhi

6749. SHRI P. ANTONY REDDY: SHRI G. S. REDDI:

- (a) whether there have been a number of thefts and burglaries from the houses at Chitra Gupta Road and Aram Bagh area in New Delhi recently:
- (b) whether it is also a fact that a Police Station is located very near these areas; and
- (c) the action taken to prevent such incidents?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS (SHRI VIDYA CHARAN SHUKLA) : (a) Only one case of theft was reported to the Police from these areas during the period 1.1.1969 to 31.3.1969. There was no case of burglary during the same period.

- (b) Yes, Sir.
- (c) Patrolling is being done intensively in the area consisting of Chitra Gupta Road and Aram Bagh.

Issue of Warrant of Tickets to Employees 6750. SHRI P. ANTONY REDDI: SHRI G. S. REDDI:

Will the Minister of HMOE AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether it is a fact that Government had announced in 1956 that a warrant of ticket would be issued to the Central Government employees under the Home Leave Travel concession; and
- (b) if so, the reasons why the warrants of tickets have not vet been issued?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS (SHRI VIDYA CHARAN SHUKLA): (a) Yes Sir. It was stated in the original orders introducing the scheme of Leave Travel Concession to Central Government employees that it was proposed to make arrangements with the Ministry of Railways for the issue of special warrants or special tickets orders

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to enable the Government servants and their families to whom these concessions are admissible to purchase railway tickets for the journeys at concessional rates.

(b) This was considered and it was decided not to pursue the proposal having regard to the fact that the issue of special ticket warrants will involve considerable additional amount of work on the part of the Railways involving considerable calculations and employment of extra staff (especially since the Government servants availing of the concession are allowed to perform the journey to home town and back by any mode of travel and by any route.)

Installation of Radars during Forth Plan

THE MINISTER OF TOURISM AND CIVIL AVIATION (DR. KARAN SINGH): (a) A scheme for installation of eight powerful storm-warning radars along the east and west coasts of India has been included in the draft Fourth Plan of the India Meteorological Department.

(b) The estimated cost of each radar is Rs. 17.46 lakhs. These radars are capable of detecting and tracking cyclones within a radius of 400 kilometers.

(c) One rader is likely to be installed at Visakhapatnam during 1969-70. A decision on the installation of the remaining seven radars will be taken after the Fourth Five Year Plan allocation has been finalised.
