Pending Bills

3668. SHRI BHIM DAHAL: Will the Minister of HOME AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

(a) whether the Union Government have received any Bills from the Sikkim Government for President's assent;

(b) if so, the details thereof; and

(c) the time by which these bill. are likely to be approved?

THE MINISTER OF HOME AFFAIRS (SHRI L.K. ADVANI): (a) and (b) Yes, Sir. The Sikkim Transfer of Land (Regulation) Bill, 1989 and the Sikkim Alienation of Land (Regulation) Bill, 1989 have been received by the Central Government for the consideration and assent of the President.
