a) the details of the functional Ayurvedic Research Centres functional in Maharashtra especially in the Thane Parliamentary constituency;

(b) whether there is any plan to set up new Ayurvedic Research Centre in the Maharashtra including Thane;

(c) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor; and

(d) the details of the funds allocated for research and development of the said Centres during the last three years and the current year?

(a) Government of India has setup Central Council for Research in Ayurvedic Sciences (CCRAS), New Delhi an autonomous organization under Ministry of Ayush for undertaking coordinating formulating, developing and promoting research on scientific lines in Ayurveda. Following three institutes under the CCRAS are functioning in the state of Maharashtra:

1. Raja Ramdeo Anandilal Podar (RRAP) Central Ayurveda Research Institute, Mumbai
2. Regional Ayurveda Research Institute, Nagpur
3. Regional Ayurveda Research Institute, Pune

(b) There is no such proposal pending as on date.
