†850. SHRI BHAGIRATH CHOUDHARY:

Will the Minister of MINES be pleased to state:

- (a) the procedure for selection under the Pradhan Mantri Khanij Kshetra Kalyan Yojana (PMKKKY) for the development of rural areas in the country;
- (b) whether any criteria has been laid down for the said scheme and if so, the details thereof;
- (c) the names of the States where people in the mining affected areas were benefitted by undertaking works for their welfare since the launch of the said scheme till December 2023 and the details thereof, State and year-wise;
- (d) the details of the various works accomplished so far in the rural areas benefitted under the said scheme in Rajasthan from 2019-20 to 2023-24, district, year and amount-wise; and
- (e) the various developmental works undertaken and the amount sanctioned for them along with the works completed under the said scheme in Ajmer Parliamentary Constituency under the Zila Khanij Foundation during the last four years and the details thereof, year and Block-wise?

ANSWER

(a) to (c): Through the amendment in Mines & Minerals (Development & Regulation) (MMDR) Act, in 2015, Government of India has made provision for establishment of District Mineral Foundation in all the districts affected by mining for taking up development and welfare projects/programs exclusively in mining affected areas. In 2015, Central Government circulated Pradhan Mantri Khanij Kshetra Kalyan Yojana (PMKKKY) guidelines and further vide order dated 15.01.2024 Central Government revised the PMKKKY guidelines with directions to State Governments to incorporate the same into the DMF rules framed by them. The guidelines duly prescribe the identification of affected areas to be covered under the scheme, and affected areas that may encompass rural areas are identified by respective DMFs in such manner as may be prescribed by the State Government in the State DMF rules. State and year-wise details of works implemented under PMKKKY is provided at Annexure I.

(d) & (e): As per the information received from State Government of Rajasthan, details of work implemented under PMKKKY in Rajasthan from 2019-20 to 2023-24, district, year and amount-wise; and works completed and amount spent in various districts of Rajasthan including that of Ajmer district during the last four years is provided at Annexure II.
