11.0½ hrs

At this stage, Prof. Sougata Ray, Shri B. Manickam Tagore and some other hon. Members came and stood on the floor near the Table.

[Translation]

...(Interruptions)

HON. SPEAKER: Hon. Members, I want to run the House. I will give everyone a chance to speak. I have given ample opportunity to everyone to say, but the House should be in order and the House should transact its business. I have given enough time and opportunity to all the Hon. Members.

...(Interruptions)

HON. SPEAKER: Hon. Members, I will also allow you to speak but You come to the Well and say that you should be allowed to speak. Please go back to your seats. I will allow you to speak If the House is in order. I will allow you to speak. Let's not argue here.

...(Interruptions)

HON. SPEAKER: You come in the Well and want to have a discussion. Please go back to your seats. Please be seated, I will allow you to speak as well.

...(Interruptions)

HON. SPEAKER: Hon Members, don't you want the House to run? Don't you want to discuss the Budget? Don't you want to have Question Hour? Do you want to raise slogans? Is it fair? Is it appropriate?

...(Interruptions)

HON. SPEAKER: I request you and them to sit down. I will allow you to speak. Please return to your seats; only then will I give you a chance to speak. Outside this house, you usually said that you are not being provided the opportunity to speak and here you are entering in the Well and raising slogans. It is unfair. The parliament has its decorum. Please maintain that decorum. I will give you all a chance to speak.
