(a): Details of scheme-wise Revised Estimates (RE) and Expenditure during the financial years 2021-22, 2022-23 and 2023-24 are as under:

(b) & (c): So far, 816 OSCs have been approved in all 36 States/UTs, out of which 786 OSCs are operational across the country including the State of West Bengal. The Ministry has approved 24 OSCs with one OSC in each of the 23 districts and one additional OSC at Siliguri in Darjeeling district. Out of these 24 approved OSCs, 22 OSCs are operational as on date including the one OSC at Hatuara, Purulia, West Bengal, Pin – 723101 in the Purulia Parliamentary Constituency.
