

Regarding need to develop an alternate route to Shivaji Marg along Sahibi River in NCT Delhi-Laid

SHRIMATI KAMALJEET SEHRAWAT (WEST DELHI): Shivaji Marg is spanning from Moti Nagar to Najafgarh in New Delhi. This road is one of the busiest road and running through very thickly populated area of the National Capital. Traffic Jam is very common phenomenon on this route specially from Raja garden to Najafgarh T Point, and it takes very long hours for the commuters to cover this span. A joint survey was also carried out by the undersigned along with District Magistrate and Delhi Police Personnel, but due to heavy traffic flow on this route, permanent solution to this problem is not visible in the present scenario. It is, therefore, requested to the concerned Ministry/Department that an alternate route to the Shivaji Marg may kindly be developed along Sahibi River which is running parallelly to this route, so that this route may be decongested. The proposed route is still functioning in certain pockets but is very narrow and not properly maintained. It is my humble request to the concerned Ministry/Department to allow to conduct the survey of the newly proposed route and develop an alternate route to Shivaji Marg. It will be a huge relief for the daily commuters in Delhi.
