

Regarding completion of the Parvan River Multipurpose Project-Laid

SHRI DUSHYANT SINGH (JHALAWAR-BARAN): I wish to draw attention of the Government towards the slow progress of the Parvan River Multipurpose Project, which is a critically important project for the people of my constituency. This ambitious project involves the construction of the dam, water tunnel, and other irrigation development projects that promise significant benefits, including improved irrigation, drinking water supply, and power generation for the Jhalawar, Kota, and Baran districts. Despite the clearances, fund allocations, technological advancements and high tech features, the project has been plagued by slow progress. The Ministry of Jal Shakti added the project to its Accelerated Irrigation Benefit Program (AIBP) but still the remaining work is progressing at a sluggish pace, which threatens to delay the project further and undermine its benefits to the region. I respectfully request that the Ministry address this matter urgently and get a status report on the project. With the new Government in the state, I urge the Ministry and the State Government to accelerate the remaining work on the Parvan River Multipurpose Project and ensure its timely completion to alleviate the water issues faced by our constituents and enhance regional development.
