(a) & (b) Augmentation of CGHS infrastructure to serve the beneficiaries more effectively and efficiently is a continuous process. At present, there are CGHS Allopathic Wellness Centres (including CGHS Polyclinic), AYUSH Wellness Centres and CGHS Extension Counter, functioning in the city of Bengaluru, as per Annexure.
