Number of Central Universities

†1087. Shri Kaushalendra Kumar:

Will the Minister of EDUCATION be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of Central Universities established/set up in the country, State/UT-wise and regionwise;
- (b) the total number of teaching and non-teaching posts sanctioned in the said Universities and the present status of appointments for the said posts;
- (c) whether the Government proposes to set up new Central Universities on the request of State Governments; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof and the number of requests pending with the Government?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF EDUCATION (DR. SUKANTA MAJUMDAR)

(a) Under the purview of Ministry of Education, there are 48 Central Universities (47 Central Universities running in regular mode and one Central University i.e. IGNOU running in distance learning mode). State/UT-wise list of Central Universities is annexed.

(b) As on 31.10.2024, there are 18940 sanctioned teaching posts and 35640 sanctioned non-teaching posts in Central Universities. Occurring of vacancies and filling thereof is a continuous process. The vacancies arise due to retirement, resignation and additional requirements on account of enhanced students' strength; the onus of filling up the posts lies on the Central Universities (CUs), which are statutory autonomous organizations established under respective Central Acts of Parliament and governed by provisions of the Acts and Statutes/Ordinances/Regulations made thereunder.

Ministry of Education and University Grants Commission (UGC) regularly monitor the recruitment in institutions. Central Universities have been directed to fill up the vacancies in regular mode. Through special recruitment drives started in September 2022, more than 11080 teaching and non-teaching positions have been filled in the Central Universities. UGC has launched a unified recruitment portal called CU-Chayan on 02.05.2023 to provide a common platform for listing of vacancies/advertisement/jobs across all Central Universities.

(c) and (d) Central Universities are envisaged to function more as pace setter institutions to provide academic leadership to other institutions in the region. Therefore, at least one Central University has been established in each state except Goa. During 12th Plan (2012-17) as approved by the National Development Council (NDC), the thrust was on consolidation of the higher education system. Expansion was to be mainly done by scaling up capacity of the existing institutions in place of setting up new institutions. Moreover, 'Education' being a concurrent subject, the State Governments are also taking various initiatives to provide greater access to higher education in their respective states. At present, there is no proposal from the State Government under consideration of this Ministry for establishment of new Central University.
