Will the Minister of NEW AND RENEWABLE ENERGY be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of the families benefitted under the Pradhan Mantri Surya Ghar Muft Bijli Yojana (PM-SGMBY), district-wise in Jharkhand and Haryana especially in the Giridih and Sonipat Lok Sabha Constituencies during each of the last three years;
- (b) the details of the funds allocated in the said constituencies for solarizing the solar powered agricultural pumps under the Pradhan Mantri Kisan Urja Suraksha Evam Utthaan Mahabhiyan (PM-KUSUM) scheme during the last three years in Jharkhand and Haryana, district-wise; and
- (c) whether the Government proposes to provide solar powered agricultural pumps at subsidized rates and if so, the district and area-wise details of the farmers benefitted from the said scheme in Jharkhand and Haryana particularly in Giridih and Sonipat Lok Sabha Constituencies?

ANSWER

(a) The Government has launched PM Surya Ghar: Muft Bijli Yojana in February 2024. The district wise details of the households benefitted by installing rooftop solar plants under the PM Surya Ghar Muft Bijli Yojana in the state of Jharkhand and Haryana including the Giridih and Sonipat Lok Sabha Constituencies are given in **Annexure I**.

(b) State-wise/ district-wise fund allocation is not made under PM-KUSUM, as it is a demand driven scheme. Further, the funds are released to States/UTs on achieving certain milestones. As on 30.11.2024, the details of fund released to state of Jharkhand and Haryana during the last 3 years and current year is as under: -
