SBM-U 2.0 IN KARNATAKA

Will the Minister for HOUSING AND URBAN AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of construction of Individual Household Latrines (IHHL), Community Toilets/Public Toilets (CT/PT) and Solid Waste Management (SWM) under Swachh Bharat Mission-Urban (SBM-U) 2.0, in Bengaluru Urban district of Karnataka; and**
- (b) the details of funds allocated and released to Karnataka under SBM-U 2.0?**

- (a): Government of India launched the Swachh Bharat Mission-Urban (SBM-U) on October 2, 2014 with the objective of Open Defecation Free (ODF) and for scientific processing of Municipal Solid Waste (MSW) generated in the urban areas of the country. To carry forward the progress made under Phase-I, SBM – Urban 2.0 was launched on 1st October, 2021 with the vision to achieve “Garbage Free” status through source segregation, door-to-door collection and scientific processing of municipal solid waste. The scheme is applicable to all Urban Local Bodies(ULBs) including ULBs in Bengaluru Urban district in Karnataka.**

Under SBM-U and SBM-U 2.0 Central Share of funds are released to the States/UTs based on the complete proposal received from the State Government duly approved by State Level Technical Committee (SLTC). Hence, no district-wise data is maintained at Ministry level.

(b): Under SBM-U, the State of Karnataka had been allocated fund to the tune of Rs. 820.96 Cr. of which Rs. 758.93 Cr. had been released based on utilisation by the State. Under SBM-U 2.0, the State of Karnataka has been allocated fund to the tune of Rs. 2245.30 Cr. of which Rs. 326.68 Cr. has been released based on utilisation by the State.
