CONSTRUCTION OF EXPRESSWAY FROM DELHI TO KATRA

630. SHRI YOGENDER CHANDOLIA:

Will the Minister of ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS

be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government is aware of the need to construct an expressway from Sector-36, Bhagwan Mahavir Marg, Heliport Rohini, Delhi to Delhi-Katra Expressway with connecting UER-II, if so, the current status of the proposal;
- (b) the details of the proposed expressway, including its length, width, alignment, and the estimated cost of construction;
- (c) the benefits that the proposed expressway is expected to provide, including reduced travel time, improved connectivity, increased economic growth and the number of people expected to benefit from the project;
- (d) the steps being taken by the Government to acquire the necessary land for the construction of the proposed National Highway;
- (e) the measures being taken to minimize the displacement of people and the impact on the environment; and
- (f) the timeline for the completion of the proposed expressway and the agencies responsible for its construction and maintenance?

(a) to (f) The process of appointment of DPR consultant for connectivity between Delhi Katra Expressway and UER II has been initiated. Further, Development of National Highways (NHs) is a continuous process. Government in Ministry of Road Transport & Highways keeps on receiving proposals for declaration/upgradation/development of NHs including development of the NHs around Delhi NCR. Decisions are taken based on outcome of DPR, fulfilment of the criteria, requirement of connectivity, inter-se priority and synergy with PM Gati Shakti National Master Plan.
