- (a) the details and status of the Chennai-Bengaluru Industrial Corridor (CBIC);
- (b) the details and the total project cost and fund released and spent on this CBIC; and
- (c) the details of status of completed projects under CBIC as on date?

ANSWER

वाणिज्य एवं उद्योग मंत्रालय में राज्य मंत्री (श्री जितिन प्रसाद) THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF COMMERCE & INDUSTRY (SHRI JITIN PRASADA)

(a) to (c): Under National Industrial corridor Development Programme (NICDP), Industrial corridors are conceived to foster global manufacturing, investment destination hubs with plug & play facility, smart cities with walk-to-work concept & creating the best in-class quality infrastructure ahead of demand. CBIC is one of the 11 Industrial corridors being taken up for development under the National Industrial Corridor Development Programme (NICDP) along the Bangalore–Chennai Expressway or National Expressway 7 (NE-7) as the transportation backbone.

Two industrial townships at Tumkuru in Karnataka and Krishnapatnam in Andhra Pradesh have been approved by GoI, and these are under development. Their updated status is as follows:

1. Tumakuru node in Karnataka:

- (a) Govt. of India has approved Tumakuru node in Karnataka for Phase 1 activation area of 1,736 acre.
- (b) Of the total project cost of Rs. 1,701 crores, Rs. 586.74 crore has been released by NICDIT.
- (c) Foundation Stone of the project was laid by the Hon`ble PM on 06th February, 2023.
- (d) Special Purpose Vehicle (SPV) has been incorporated for development of the Project. Project Management Consultant (PMC) & EPC Contractor has been appointed for trunk infrastructure and associated works.

2. Krishnapatnam node in Andhra Pradesh:

- (a) Govt. of India has approved Krishnapatnam node in Andhra Pradesh for an activation area of 2,500 acre.
- (b) Out of the total project cost of Rs. 2,139 crores, Rs. 533.86 crore has been released by NICDIT.
- (C) Foundation Stone of the project was laid by the Hon`ble PM on 09th January, 2025.
- (d) Special Purpose Vehicle (SPV) has been incorporated for development of the Project. Project Management Consultant (PMC) & EPC Contractor has been appointed for trunk infrastructure and associated works.
