TEXTILE PROCESSING PROJECTS UNDER IPDS

1296. SHRI G LAKSHMINARAYANA: SHRI APPALANAIDU KALISETTI:

Will the Minister of TEXTILES वस्त्र मंत्री be pleased to state :

- (a) the details of new processing parks and existing textile processing projects approved and targets achieved under the Integrated Processing Development Scheme (IPDS), State-wise;
- (b) the current status of these projects in terms of physical and financial progress including funds allocated, released and utilized, project and State-wise including Andhra Pradesh;
- (c) the technologies implemented under IPDS in both new and existing clusters to ensure compliance with environmental standards particularly in managing effluents and controlling pollution;
- (d) whether there are any pending proposals particularly from Andhra Pradesh under IPDS and if so, the details thereof; and
- (e) whether any delays have been encountered in the implementation of these projects and if so, the reasons therefor?

उत्तर ANSWER वस्त्र राज्य मंत्री (**श्री पबित्र मार्घेरिटा**) THE MINISTER OF STATE FOR TEXTILES (SHRI PABITRA MARGHERITA)

(a) to (e): In order to facilitate the textile industry to meet the required environmental standards and to support new Common Effluent Treatment Plants (CETP)/ upgradation of CETPs in processing clusters/ processing parks, the Government is implementing Integrated Processing Development Scheme (IPDS) since 2013. The scheme aims to facilitate the Indian textile industry to become globally competitive using environmentally friendly processing standards and technology. The scheme is also be applicable for technology upgradation and capacity enhancement in existing Textile Clusters. The scheme was in implementation upto 31.03.2021. Now, the scheme is being implemented for completing ongoing projects only. Under the Scheme, 6 projects have been sanctioned which are currently under implementation. Project wise status of physical and financial progress including technology is being implemented is given in Annexure.

Contractual disputes and issues related to land allotment have led to delay in implementation of some projects.

No proposal under IPDS is pending in the Ministry for setting up of any project in Andhra Pradesh State.
