- (a) the total number of accidents reported on the Solapur-Pune highway near Savaleshwar village during the last five years;
- (b) the manner in which the Government plans to address safety concerns in this area;
- (c) the current allocation for road infrastructure development in Solapur district and the funds earmarked for the construction of a service road and flyover at Savaleshwar; and
- (d) the timeline for commencing and completing the construction of the service road and flyover at Savaleshwar and the steps being taken to ensure timely execution of the project?

- (a) A total of 35 accidents have been reported in the vicinity of Savaleshwar village over the past five years.
- (b) to (d) To ensure safety, an under pass with service roads at estimated cost of about Rs 50 crore is under process of approval in National Highways Authority of India (NHAI). The construction of the underpass is expected to take one year after its approval.
