CSR FUND FOR CONSERVATION AND MAINTENANCE WORK

- SHRI Y S AVINASH REDDY:
 Will the Minister of CULTURE be pleased to state:
- (a) whether the Government has been receiving the proposals for release of CSR Funds for conservation and maintenance work of historical monuments in the country;
- (b) if so, the details thereof including Andhra Pradesh; and
- (c) the action plan formulated for conserving and maintaining the monuments and other historical sites in Andhra Pradesh along with the funds allocated and released so far?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF CULTURE AND TOURISM (SHRI GAJENDRA SINGH SHEKHAWAT)

- (a) Yes, Sir. Government has received Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR) funding & through National Culture Fund (NCF) for conservation and maintenance work of historical
- monuments in the country. NCF has received Rs. 1861.60 Lakh during the last three years. However, no CSR fund has been received/spent through NCF in Andhra Pradesh during the last three years. The details of projects undertaken through NCF in last three years are given in Annexure-1.

Further, Adopt A Heritage Program 2.0 has been launched by the Ministry of Culture exclusively for protected monuments of national importance to create a framework for engaging with private/public sector companies and NGOs/Trusts/Societies, etc. to develop/provide amenities through CSR funds to enhance visitors' experience. As of date, a total of 21 MoUs have been executed across various states. However, no MoU has been signed for any monument from Andhra Pradesh.

(c) Archaeological Survey of India (ASI) takes up conservation and maintenance work of centrally protected monuments/sites in the country, including state of Andhra Pradesh, as per requirement and availability of resources. The detail of funds allocated for conservation and maintenance of monuments/sites in the state of Andhra Pradesh during last three years is given as under:
