

Regarding need to release funds and recruit staff in Kishanganj Centre of Aligarh Muslim University in Bihar-Laid

DR. MOHAMMAD JAWED (KISHANGANJ): I wish to draw the attention of the Government to the urgent matter of the lack of fund allocation for the AMU Kishanganj Centre. The Kishanganj Centre was established in 2013 to bridge the gap in lack of access to quality education in Kishanganj and adjoining districts. A decade long delay in release of funds and allocation of teaching and non-teaching staff for the AMU Kishanganj campus, since 2014 has kept the centre non-functional. For the youth of Seemanchal, this centre represents an extremely valuable opportunity to contribute towards India's growth and yet it simply remains a dream even in 2024. The Kishanganj Centre has an aim to establish three new departments of studies and research every year. All these plans have been failed to be materialized because of a shortage of funds and staff. The students of Seemanchal are still waiting for AMU Kishanganj and still dreaming about being a part of our country's march towards progress. For them and their dreams, on their behalf, I humbly request that this matter be considered on an urgent basis and funds as well as staff be allocated as soon as possible to save AMU Kishanganj.
