

Regarding DeepSeek AI Technology

ADV. GOWAAL KAGADA PADAVI (NANDURBAR): Thank you, Chairman Sir, for giving me an opportunity to speak today.

I wish to bring to your kind attention an issue regarding the AI technology of China named DeepSeek. Some questions were asked to the DeepSeek AI technology about Tibet being an independent country but it seems that the AI technology answered that Tibet has always been under control of the Republic of China. I have a screenshot to prove the same. Then the DeepSeek technology was asked about whether Uttar Pradesh is a part of India and whether Andhra Pradesh is a part of India, it gave a detailed answer that yes, it is a part of India. But when it was asked if the State of Arunachal Pradesh is a part of India, then the DeepSeek app refused to give any specific answer and it said, ? Sorry, that is beyond my current scope.
