## Regarding need to reinstate English medium education system and CBSE curriculum in Andhra Pradesh Government Schools-Laid

SHRI P. V. MIDHUN REDDY (RAJAMPET): The introduction of English-medium and the CBSE curriculum in 1000 Government schools during the regime of last Government in Andhra Pradesh significantly improved educational opportunities for students. By adopting English as the medium of instruction, students were better prepared to compete at the national level and access global opportunities. However, this policy has been reversed, thereby discontinuing CBSE curriculum and restoring Telugu-medium in these Government schools. This abrupt change has forced many parents to shift their children to private schools, which charge exorbitant fees, making quality English education inaccessible to economically disadvantaged students. Those who cannot afford private schooling are now deprived of the opportunity to study in English, impacting their future prospects. Education policies must remain consistent to safeguard students? futures. I therefore urge the Minister of Education to reinstate English-medium education and the CBSE curriculum in Andhra Pradesh?s Government schools; ensuring students receive the skills necessary for higher education, employment, and international opportunities in an increasingly globalised world.
