Regarding need to establish PM Vishwakarma Skill Centre in Mannar, Kerala to revive the traditional brass industry of the region-Laid

Additionally, I request the introduction of Region-Specific Product Certification for Mannar brassware to enhance its market value and secure Geographical Indication (GI) status, protecting its authenticity. A targeted Incentive Scheme with tax rebates, low-interest loans, and export promotion initiatives will further aid artisans and small-scale manufacturers. I appeal to the Central Government to take urgent steps to safeguard and promote this iconic industry, ensuring its sustainability and the economic welfare of its artisans.
