

Need to release funds allocated to Aligarh Muslim University (AMU) Centre in Kishanganj, Bihar.-laid

DR. MOHAMMAD JAWED (KISHANGANJ): The Aligarh Muslim University (AMU) Centre in Kishanganj, Bihar, was established to provide higher education opportunities in one of the most educationally backward regions of the country. Despite its sanctioned status, the Central Government has not released the necessary funds for its construction and development. Additionally, the approval for teaching and non-teaching staff remains pending, severely affecting the academic operations of the centre. This delay is denying thousands of students access to quality education and contradicts the Government's stated commitment to educational inclusivity. The people of Kishanganj and surrounding districts have been waiting for over a decade for this institution to become fully functional. The non-allocation of funds is a grave injustice to the aspirations of the youth in this region. I urge the Government to immediately release the required funds, approve faculty and staff recruitment, and expedite the full operationalization of AMU Kishanganj in the interest of educational equity and regional.
