Regarding construction of underpass at Dharmadam railway station in Kannur district, Kerala

SHRI K. SUDHAKARAN (KANNUR): Sir, I rise today to bring to your attention an issue of urgent public importance. They need an underpass at Dharmadam Railway Station which is in my constituency, Kannur. The lack of this critical infrastructure has put countless lives at risk, and severely affected mobility in the region. The railway line and the National Highway-17 has divided this area, leaving people with no choice but to cross the railway tracks due to the absence of an underpass.
