

Need to establish Vishram Kendras (Resting Centres) near the government hospitals for benefit of patients and their attendants ? Laid

Between 1995 and 2014, India's annual hospitalization rate has more than doubled, increasing from 16.6 to 37.0 per 1,000 individuals. This sharp rise underscores not just the need for better healthcare facilities but also for dignified support systems for those who stand by their ailing loved ones. Anyone who has visited a Government hospital knows the distressing sight of worried family members sleeping on cold floors, spending days and nights without basic amenities, their suffering often overlooked. Moved by this reality, I took the initiative to allocate my MPLADS funds to establish Vishram Kendra in my Parliamentary constituency, Anantapur, right next to Government hospital. These centres will provide patients and their attendants a safe, comfortable place to rest, ensuring they do not have to endure further hardship while caring for their loved ones. A small step like this can make a world of difference to thousands of struggling families across India. Let us work together to build a more humane and patient-centric healthcare system. Hence, I urge the Union Government to consider establishing Vishram Kendras near the Government hospitals in the country.
