The aquatic animals like fish etc. are dying in this river and we have to save and conserve it immediately.

This Kumbh Mela will be organized during monsoon. So, we have to be cautious about the mud, flood and heavy rains. We should also ensure the basic infrastructure like hospitals, roads, bridges, and other amenities needed for tourism activities there.
