Regarding need to print the question paper of NET and UPSC Examinations for ?Santhali? language in OI Chiki Script-Laid

SHRI KALIPADA SAREN KHERWAL (JHARGRAM): The teaching of Santhali using Ol Chiki script has been introduced from primary to university levels both as language and subject as well as medium of instruction since the 2008 academic session in West Bengal. Besides this, the Santhali education is being updated in various universities of West Bengal, Jharkhand and Odisha. As of now, Santhali is taught at PG and UG levels in 14 universities and 62 colleges respectively. More than 350 schools of primary and secondary levels in West Bengal, the Santhali is being taught using Ol Chiki script. Numerous aspirant students are pursuing their higher studies using OI Chiki script; and thousands of students are appearing in various examinations like NET and UPSC every year. Presently, the Santhali question paper of NET and UPSC examinations are being provided in Devnagari script. Santhali being a recognised language, the Santhal people globally accepted and using Ol Chiki script as Standard for Santhali language. The Sahitya Akademi also accepted and approved the one language one script policy for nurturing the Santhali literature. Therefore, I would request the concerned department to print the question paper of NET and UPSC examinations for Santhali in Ol Chiki script only instead of Devnagari script.
