

Need for an underpass at OKUP School along National Highway No. 66 in Kannur, Kerala.-laid

SHRI K. SUDHAKARAN (KANNUR): I wish to draw the attention of the Government to the urgent need for the construction of an underpass at OKUP School along NH 66 at CH 161 + 340 in Kannur. This location is a crucial route for buses operating between Thalassery and Kannur, and the absence of an underpass is causing severe inconvenience to local residents and bus operators. Currently, residents on the eastern side of NH66 are forced to cross the Oorpazhachi Kavu LUV, traverse the Chala bypass, and cross two railway tracks to reach the Nadal bus stop, which poses serious safety risks, especially for school-going children and senior citizens. The lack of proper infrastructure is creating heavy traffic congestion and operational delays for bus services, affecting the smooth flow of public transport. Repeated protests by residents and transport operators highlight the gravity of the issue. Immediate action to construct an underpass at this location will significantly improve public safety, ease traffic congestion, and enhance connectivity. I urge the Government to address this matter with urgency and provide a favourable response at the earliest.
