

Regarding alleged proposed auction of the lands of Hyderabad Central University

SHRI KONDA VISHWESHWAR REDDY (CHEVELLA): The previous TRS-BRS Government left Telangana totally bankrupt with rupees eight lakh crore and resorted to selling Telangana land. Madam, the current Congress Government also is resorting to the same thing.

I want to draw the attention of the House to a matter of great concern. The Telangana Government has taken a decision to auction 400 acres of ecologically sensitive Hyderabad Central University lands. This land is a home of unique rock formation with rich biodiversity. There are 734 species of plants and 220 species of birds. Moreover, the iconic mushroom rock and lakes in this geological heritage are part of the landscape. The University of Hyderabad's community including students, faculty, and residents are strongly opposed to this. There is police action on them with brutal police force. The Telangana Industrial Infrastructure is planning to go ahead.

Madam, through you, I request the Government to immediately explore options to halt the auction process and set up a review committee. Thank you, Madam.
