Regarding supply of drinking water

SHRI SANJAY UTTAMRAO DESHMUKH (YAVATMAL-WASHIM): Hon. Chairperson, Amrit Yojana worth Rs 302 crore was sanctioned for my city Yavatmal in 2017 and it was to be completed within 3 years. But, it is now more than 9 years and the work is still incomplete. This scheme meant to provide tap water regularly. But, the people are still suffering and the drinking water is being supplied once in a fortnight.

Around 302 crores have been spent under this scheme but the people still facing water scarcity in this area. For Darwha city, Rs 34.34 crore was spent under Maharashtra Suvarna Jayanti Nagarotthan Abhiyan for drinking water supply in year 2016. But, it is also incomplete till date. Same scheme was sanctioned worth Rs 43 crore for Digras city too and it is also incomplete. Government keep on spending crores of rupees, but the project are still incomplete and people are also suffering a lot due to poor implementation of these schemes. So, an In-depth enquiry should be initiated to find out the reasons due to which it has been delayed and all the officers and contractors should be punished for this inordinate delay.
