

Regarding Need to expedite clearance to construction work of Kishanganj Centre, Bihar of Aligarh Muslim University- Laid

DR. MOHAMMAD JAWED (KISHANGANJ): The Kishanganj Centre of Aligarh Muslim University was established over a decade ago with the promise of expanding quality higher education in the region. Unfortunately, despite land being allotted, the Centre still lacks its own campus and continues to operate from a temporary facility. This has severely limited its capacity, restricting it to just one course due to space constraints. The long-pending construction has been halted by the National Mission for Clean Ganga, citing the land's location in a floodplain. The matter was referred to the National Green Tribunal (NGT). However, in a baffling turn, construction of a police line also on the same floodplain has resumed, despite both projects being stayed earlier. As AMU Center is still awaiting for clearance, I urge the Minister of Education to intervene and ensure that the AMU Kishanganj Centre gets its rightful campus without further delay.
