Regarding problems being faced by the Bengali speaking migrant workers at Jai Hind Colony in Vasant Kunj, New Delhi-Laid

SHRIMATI JUNE MALIAH (MEDINIPUR): I would like to draw the attention of the Minister of Home Affairs to the grave humanitarian crisis unfolding at Jai Hind Colony in Vasant Kunj, New Delhi, home to a large population of Bengali-speaking migrant workers. In recent days, electricity connections have been disconnected, water supply halted, and private water tankers blocked by law enforcement. These actions have reportedly been carried out despite the matter being sub-judice, causing immense distress to hundreds of working-class families. Residents are being subjected to forcible eviction without proper rehabilitation or legal recourse. Many of them are Indian citizens who have lived and worked in the city for decades. I urge the Government to ensure immediate restoration of essential services, put an urgent halt to the eviction drive, and conduct a fair, lawful, and humane review of the matter in consultation with all stakeholders.
