

Need to set up an inquiry into the import of sub-standard seamless pipes and tubes from China-Laid

SHRI SUNIL DATTATREY TATKARE (RAIGAD): The industry of seamless pipes and tubes is large and provides crucial supplies to India's energy sectors. The demand for seamless pipes in FY 2024-25 is over 1.3 million metric tonnes (MT) while production capacity is higher, at over 1.95 million metric tonnes (MT). However, the industry faces challenges from China, with imports of seamless pipes from China increasing by nearly six times between FY 2021-22 and FY 2024-25. Despite the imposition of an anti-dumping duty on seamless pipes and tubes from China, there have been allegations of bypassing these restrictions through over-invoicing and mixing imported seamless pipes and tubes with Indian manufactured seamless pipes and tubes to sell to government projects, despite the prohibition of Chinese-manufactured pipes in government-funded sectors. Further, there are also allegations of imports of sub-standard quality seamless pipes and tubes, which make their way to critical sectors like energy. These are serious allegations which merit further investigation, and if found true, would necessitate prompt action. Considering the above, I humbly urge the Minister to look into the matter and open an inquiry into the matter of imports of seamless pipes and tubes from China. This would help realise the PM's vision for Make in India.

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
