

Need to provide stoppage to Hundry intercity Express at Malakpet Railway Station in Hyderabad.-laid

SHRIMATI D. K. ARUNA (MAHBUBNAGAR): I would like to bring to the kind notice of the Government the need for a halt for the Hundry inter City Express train at Malakpet Railway Station in Hyderabad. In this connection, I am to state that the Hundry Inter City Express train (Train No. 17027/17028) currently runs every day from Secunderabad to Kurnool Town and vice-versa, but it does not have a scheduled stop at Malakpet Station. The local people of the Malakpet area and other passengers several times requested me that stopping the said train at Malakpet Station would be very much convenient for senior citizens, fruits and vegetable farmers. students, general passengers, private job holders, and businessmen from other districts also. Moreover, passengers also say that Malakpet Station is near to the Malakpet Metro Railway Station, the City RTC bus stop, and the MGBS district RTC Central bus station. Stopping the train at Malakpet Station would allow passengers to easily connect to other forms of transportation and reach various destinations in Hyderabad City to complete their work without any wastage of time and with less fares also. The local people also requested that the timing of the Hundry Inter City Express train at Kacheguda Railway Station be changed from 5:10 PM to 5:30 PM to avoid conflicts with the Chengalpattu Express train (Train No. 17652) which departs from Kacheguda Railway Station at 5:00 PM. Therefore, I request the Hon'ble Minister of Railways to kindly intervene in the matter and take steps to provide a halt for the Hundry Inter City Express train at Malakpet Railway Station and also review the timing of the train at Kacheguda Railway Station.
