

Regarding need for infrastructure facilities and technological upgrading in Industrial Training Institutes (ITIs) in Bapatla Parliamentary Constituency, Andhra Pradesh-Laid

In Bapatla district?ITI Gudavalli was established in 1980 and the ITI Nizampatnam has been set up recently. Despite consistently achieving 100% admissions, strong student performance in the All India Trade Test, and high student placement rates, these institutes struggle with inadequate infrastructure. Despite their performance, both ITIs lack basic infrastructure, including proper classrooms, workshops, and amenities such as toilets, drinking water, fans etc. As a result, students are deprived of a conducive learning environment. Additionally, due to severe space constraints, they are also unable to introduce short-term skill development courses, limiting both the quality and reach of training. In light of their proven contribution to skill development and employability in the region, I urge the Hon?ble Minister of Skill Development and Entrepreneurship to allocate funds to these ITIs in my Parliamentary Constituency of Bapatla to strengthen their infrastructure and ensure technological upgradations. This will enable them to further the NDA Government?s vision of building a robust, skilled and modern workforce.
