

**Regarding need to ensure efficient functionality of Nandi Medical College and Research Institute at Chikkaballapur in Karnataka- Laid**

**DR. K. SUDHAKAR (CHIKKBALLAPUR):** I wish to draw the attention of the Government to the alarming state of Nandi Medical College and Research Institute in Chikkaballapur, a centrally sponsored initiative under PMSSY meant to enhance healthcare and medical education in Karnataka. Shockingly, it is among 27 colleges penalised by the National Medical Commission for failing to meet basic standards. Despite having 150 MBBS seats, the college lacks essential medical equipment, adequate faculty, and hospital staff. Students are deprived of clinical training due to non-functional ICUs, OTs, and wards. Even completed hospital blocks remain closed?now occupied by stray dogs, cats, and rodents. The situation is worsened by basic infrastructure failures?water scarcity, poor network connectivity, and inadequate ventilation?severely hampering academics and hospital operations. A National Institution cannot be allowed to crumble due to negligence. I urge the Union Government to intervene, expedite pending approvals, and ensure the hospital and college function at full capacity. Let us restore this asset to serve our youth and our citizens?as originally envisioned.
