I urge the Union Government to deploy central agencies like the NIA and cybercrime units to thoroughly investigate the source of these threats; ensure coordinated 24x7 security service between Punjab Police and central forces; issue a formal assurance in the House on the protection of all religious sites from such threats; and frame a national strategy for digital surveillance and protection of religious sites. Sri Harmandir Sahib is a symbol of India?s unity and peace. Its protection must be a national priority.
