**(a) to (d): In Uttar Pradesh, the following airports, namely Agra, Prayagraj, Bareilly, Kanpur, Hindon, Kushinagar, Aligarh, Azamgarh, Shravasti, Moradabad and Chitrakoot have been developed and operationalized under RCS-UDAN. Saharanpur Airport is also ready for operations. Further, commercial flight operations have commenced at Ayodhya Airport. A total of 87 routes have been operationalized in Uttar Pradesh under the UDAN Scheme.**

**The Government has recently announced the launch of the modified UDAN Scheme to increase regional connectivity to 120 new destinations across the country, including Uttar Pradesh and to cater to 4 crore passengers in the next 10 years. The scheme will also support helipads and smaller airports in hilly, aspirational and North East region districts.**
