HOUSES CONSTRUCTED UNDER PMAY-G

3744. Shri P P Chaudhary:

Will the Minister of RURAL DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) the targets set under the Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana-Gramin (PMAY-G) scheme and the total number of houses constructed so far under PMAY-G, State/UT-wise particularly in the Pali Lok Sabha Constituency;**
- (b) whether it is true that the Ministry has achieved saturation of eligible households identified through the 2011 Census list and the Awaas survey and if so, the details thereof; and**
- (c) the progress made in terms of housing approvals and completion of construction under the scheme, State/UT-wise particularly for Pali Lok Sabha Constituency?**

(a) to (c): In order to achieve the objective of "Housing for All" in rural areas, the Ministry of Rural Development is implementing Pradhan Mantri Awaas Yojana- Gramin (PMAY-G) with effect from 1st April 2016 to provide assistance to eligible rural households for the construction of pucca houses with basic amenities. The Union Cabinet has approved the proposal for the continuation of PMAY-G during FY 2024-25 to 2028-29 for the construction of 2 crore additional rural houses. As on 7.8.2025, a total target of 4.12 crore has been allocated by the Ministry, out of which 3.84 crore houses have been sanctioned by States/UTs and 2.82 crore houses are completed.

The details of total targets allocated, houses sanctioned and houses completed under PMAY-G, State-wise and for Pali Lok Sabha Constituency are given in Annexure-I.

The Ministry has achieved saturation of eligible households identified through the existing SECC-2011 list and the Awaas+ 2018 list in all the States/UTs except for the States of Jharkhand, Tamil Nadu, West Bengal & Karnataka. The UTs of Delhi, Chandigarh and Puducherry are not implementing PMAY-G.

In accordance with the approval of the Union Cabinet for the continuation of PMAY-G during FY 2024-25 to 2028-29, a new survey is also being conducted for the identification of additional eligible households by the States/ UTs using eKYC face based authentication through the Awaas+ 2024 mobile app and with modified exclusion parameters.
