RGSA IN HIMACHAL PRADESH

†3788. DR. RAJEEV BHARADWAJ:

Will the Minister of PANCHAYATI RAJ be pleased to state:

- (a) the amount proposes to incur under the Rashtriya Gram Swaraj Abhiyan (RGSA) and the percentage share to be incurred by the Union and the State Governments;
- (b) the number of people trained so far in Himachal Pradesh under the Abhiyan, district-wise; and
- (c) the number of people to be trained after the expansion of Abhiyan?

ANSWER

(a) The Revamped Centrally Sponsored Scheme of Rashtriya Gram Swaraj Abhiyan (RGSA) approved for implementation from the financial year 2022-23 to 2025-26 at an outlay of Rs. 5911 cr. which includes Central Share of Rs. 3700 crore and State Share of Rs. 2211 cr. The funding pattern for State Components is in the ratio of 60:40 among Centre and States respectively, except North Eastern States, Hilly States and Union Territory (UT) of Jammu & Kashmir where Central and State share is in the ration of 90:10. For other UTs, Central share is 100%.

(b) & (c) As per the information available on Training Management Portal (TMP), participants trained Institute-wise/District-wise in the State of Himachal Pradesh is at **Annexure-I**. The scheme is demand-driven in nature, and funds have been released to States/UTs, including Himachal Pradesh, for various components which includes Capacity Building and Training (CB&T), based on the respective Annual Action Plans submitted by the States/UTs and approved by the Central Empowered Committee (CEC) of RGSA.
