SHRI G LAKSHMINARAYANA:**

Will the **Minister of HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE** be pleased to State:

- a) The details of funds allocated, released and utilised under the Tertiary Care programme during the last five years, State/UT-wise, component -wise and year-wise
- b) the details of number and location of healthcare facilities supported or established under each component of the Tertiary Care Programme -Tobacco Control, Drug De-addiction Control, National Mental Health Programme, Trauma Care, Cancer and NCD Control, Elderly Health Care, Blindness Control, and Telemedicine in the country, State/UT-wise particularly in Andhra Pradesh;
- c) the current operational status of these facilities including the number of facilities that are non-functional, underutilised or delayed -State/UT-wise;
- d) the details of vacancies in medical, paramedical and technical posts sanctioned under the Programme, State/UT-wise; and
- e) whether any proposals from State Governments, especially Andhra Pradesh for new facilities, additional funding or expansion under these schemes are pending and if so, the details thereof?

(a) to (e) The details of funds allocated, released and utilized, etc. and the location of health care facilities supported/established under seven schemes of tertiary care programme of Ministry of Health & Family Welfare are annexed as **Annexure-A**. Under Tertiary care Programme, no regular posts of Paramedical and technical posts have been sanctioned. Although some proposals have been received from State Governments for funding under the Tertiary Care programme, no new project is being considered for inclusion in the existing Scheme of this Ministry. This is because the Scheme is approved for continuation upto 31.03.2026 with the mandate to complete already approved projects and no committed liability beyond the financial outlay is being created.
